OUR STORY

In 1751, a line was surveyed straight across the Delmarva Peninsula to indicate the southern boundary of Delaware. The line began at what early Swedish settlers called Cape Henlopen, but is now known as Fenwick Island. The confusion of the placement of Cape Henlopen, which is 24 miles north in Lewes, ensued a long-standing dispute between the Penns (Delaware) and the Calverts (Maryland), with the latter claiming the Lewes cape should have been the start of the boundary line. Ironically, a map commissioned by Charles Calvert in 1732 was used to decide the matter, which showed Cape Henlopen at Fenwick Island, though this map was based on a 1651 map by Nicholas Visscher owned by William Penn. Calvert had accepted Penn's map which depicted Cape Henlopen at approximately 38°27' N, which is where the inspiration for the name "38 Degrees" came from!
